<b>Topic:</b>	Learn about Poland via Social Media.
<b>Age:</b>	10-12
<b>Time:</b>	45min

<b>Aim of this lesson:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To familiarize students with the national symbols of Poland, its currency, language</li> <li>- Presentation of Poland's position in Europe, its neighbors</li> <li>- Presentation of the most interesting places in Poland</li> <li>- Presentation of the most famous Poles</li> <li>- Presentation of dishes characteristic for Poland</li> <li>- Use of basic English vocabulary</li> <li>- Use of basic technical devices, Internet</li> </ul>
<b>Introduction:</b>	...
<b>Tools:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- interactive whiteboard</li> <li>- projector</li> <li>- computer / mobile phone with Internet access</li> </ul>
<b>Process</b>	
	<b>Step 1</b> 5 min <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Presentation of the goals of the lesson</li> <li>- A reminder of the rules for working with the telephone</li> <li>- Providing the topic of the lesson</li> </ul>
<b>Teachers notes (if needed)</b>	...
	<b>Step 2</b> 5 min - The teacher has a talk about Poland; asks them if they have ever been to Poland, and if they liked it. Then the teacher displays the film presenting our country and our school.

	<b>Step 3</b> 10 min Teacher displays the activity „Where are Poland's neighbours?“ prepared earlier on the platform Learning Apps. The aim of the task is to find Poland's neighbors on the map of Europe. Students do the exercise on the interactive whiteboard.

	<b>Step 4</b> 10 min Teacher displays the activity „The Crossword about Poland“ prepared earlier on the platform Learning Apps. Students do the crosswords on the interactive whiteboard together.

<b>Step 5</b> 10 min	
The teacher asks students to use their phones and enter the kahoot.it website, type their names and access code. Students solve a quiz consisting of 20 questions. Questions appear on the interactive whiteboard, along with possible answers, and the students click the selected answer on the phones.
